Svetlana is pleased to present Meat and Potatoes, an exhibition of new works by Walter Smith.

Smith shows a suite of five new drawings that collide hand-painted elements with manipulated visual debris—material rescued from the exploded screen of Hollywood fiction. Smith uses cues from modern psychoanalysis to reconsider the latent content of recent filmic narratives such as Transformers, etc.

These works haunt contemporary cinema as the center of their orbit; they mime movie posters and trendy painting, projecting a sexual primacy that fills the gallery with nervous energy. A sixth piece is a hand-rendered drawing on an isolated gallery wall by a commissioned production designer.

Walter Smith (b. 1980) is an artist living and working in New York.
